## Right to Information (RTI) Act Declaration

The Right to Information (RTI), 2005 an act of the Parliament of India, came into force on 15 June, 2005. It provides for setting the practical regime of the RTI for citizens and replaces the former Freedom of information Act, 2002. This act was enacted to merge the fundamental right in the Indian constitution 'Freedom of speech'. It offers RTI for citizens to secure access to information under the control of public authorities in order to promote transparency and accountability in the working of every public authority. All Universities and Colleges established by law made by Parliament or by State Legislature or by notification by the appropriate Government or owned, controlled or substantially financed directly or indirectly by funds provided by the Government shall come within the meaning of a Public Authority under this Act.
