
MEETINGS

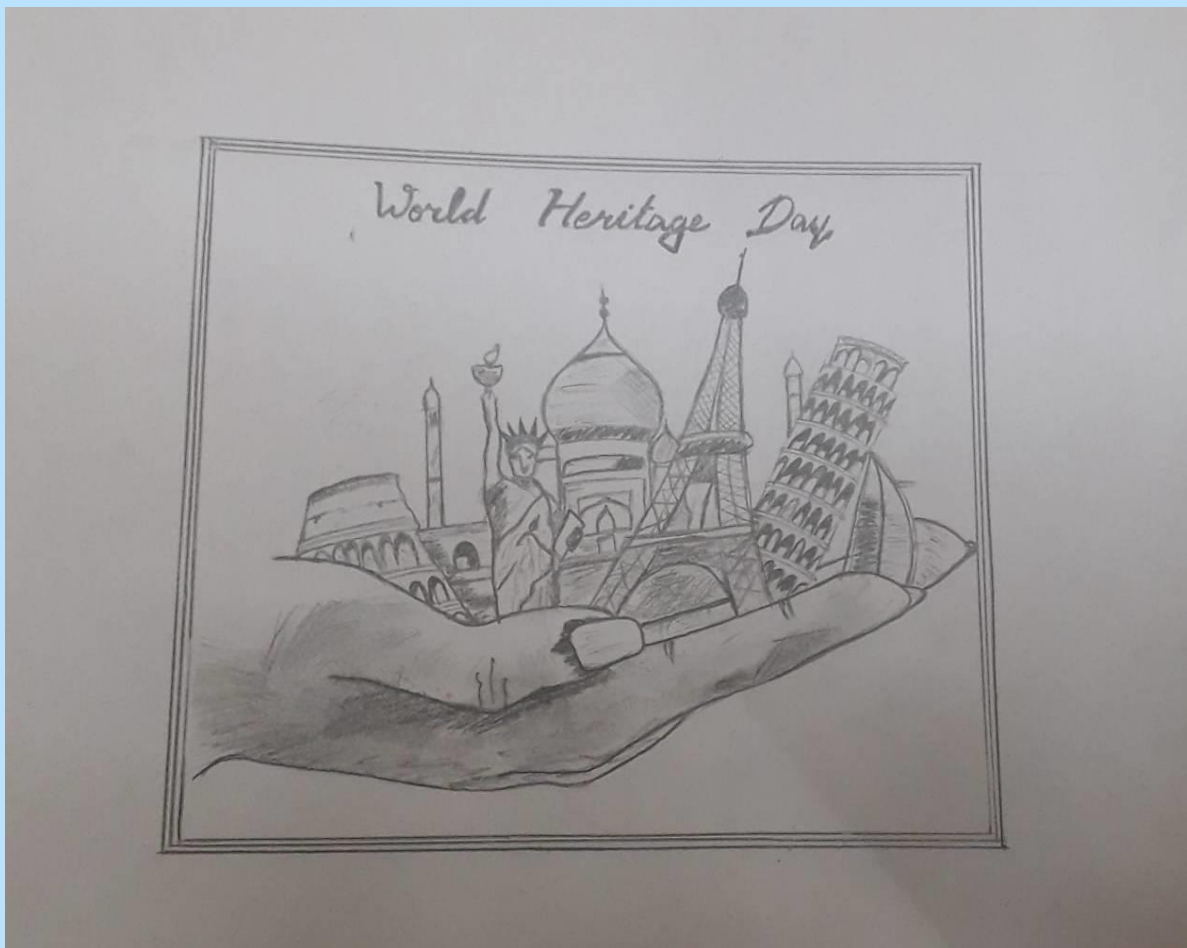
