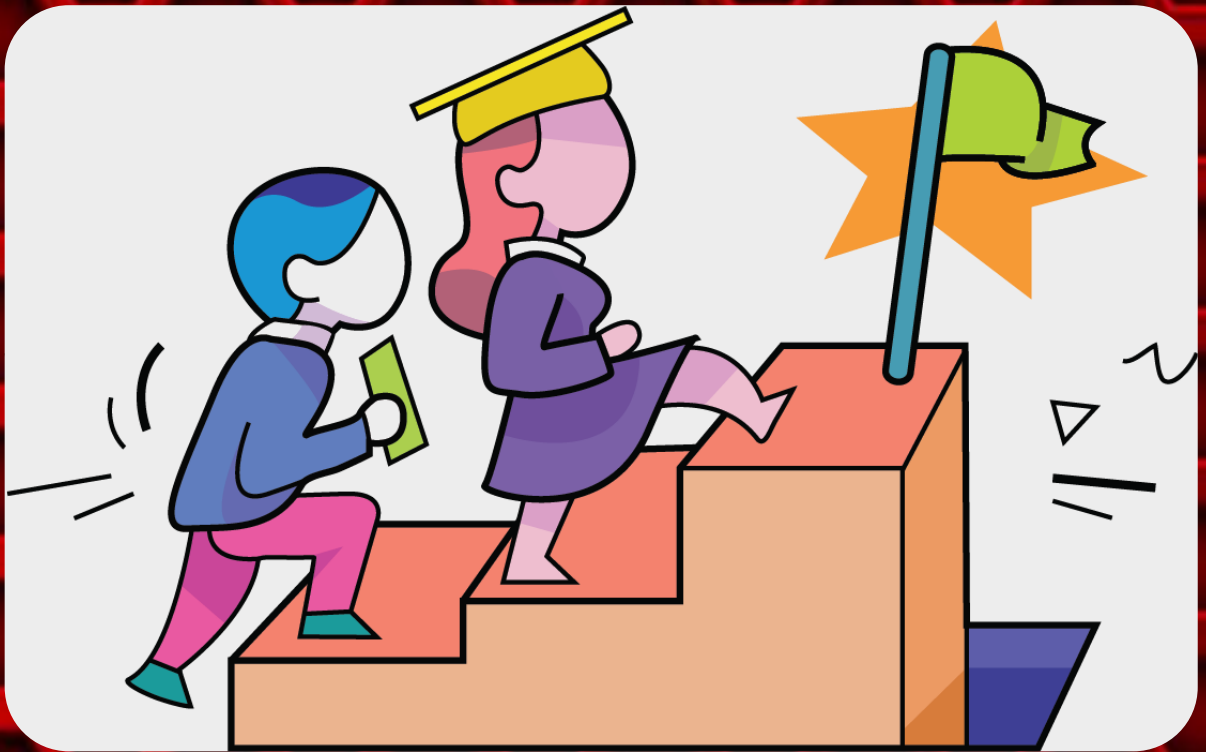

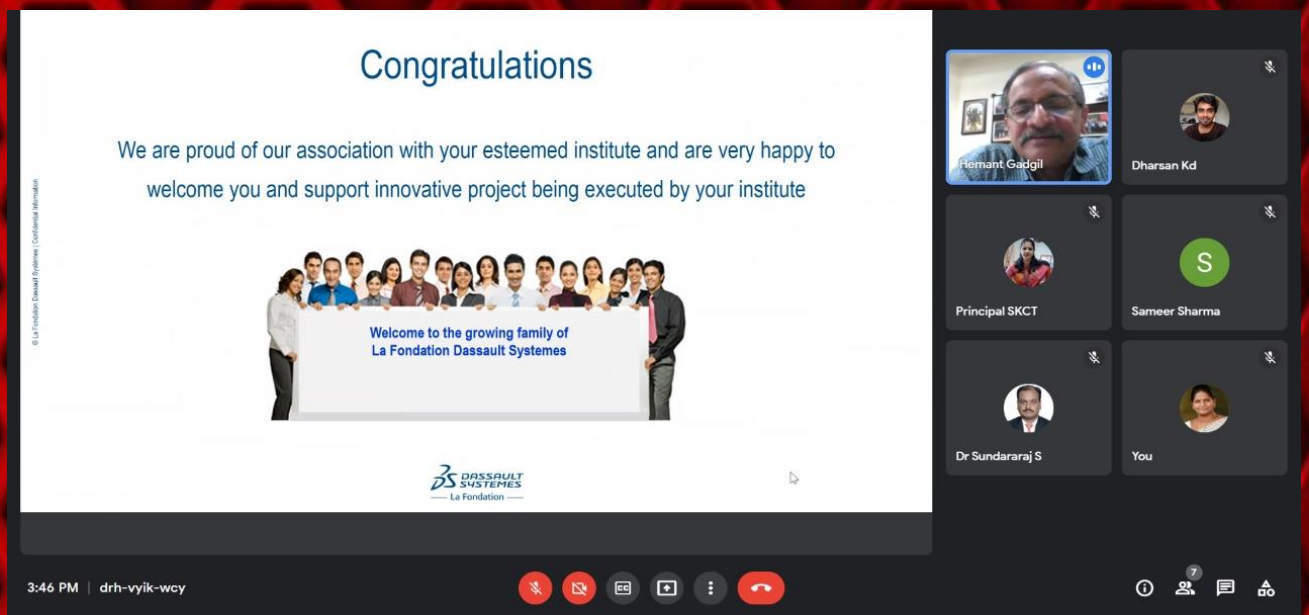

ISSUE OF THE CASE

The Vice President of Pointless Pencils Pvt Ltd reviewed the financial statement of the company and found that the statement is not projecting the product profitability of the company. As the company is manufacturing three different types of pencils (light black, medium black and hard black), Vice President is inclined to know the most profit-making product.

1. Why a financial statement does not disclose the product profitability of a company?

The Financial Statement of a company comprises of the Income Statement, Balance Sheet, Cash Flow Statement and Statement of Retained earnings. The financial statement presents the consolidated view of financial results. In this case the sales of all the three different types of pencils would be reported as one figure on the income statement. It would thus be difficult for a reader of the financial statement to comprehend how much sale could be attributed to each type of pencil. Similarly the expenses incurred would be categorized under appropriate heads like Selling, General & Administrative Expenses, Financial expenses and the like and would not be presented separately for each type of pencil. Product profitability is more a concern for the management than for the shareholder. The shareholder would be interested to know the overall results rather than product specific results.

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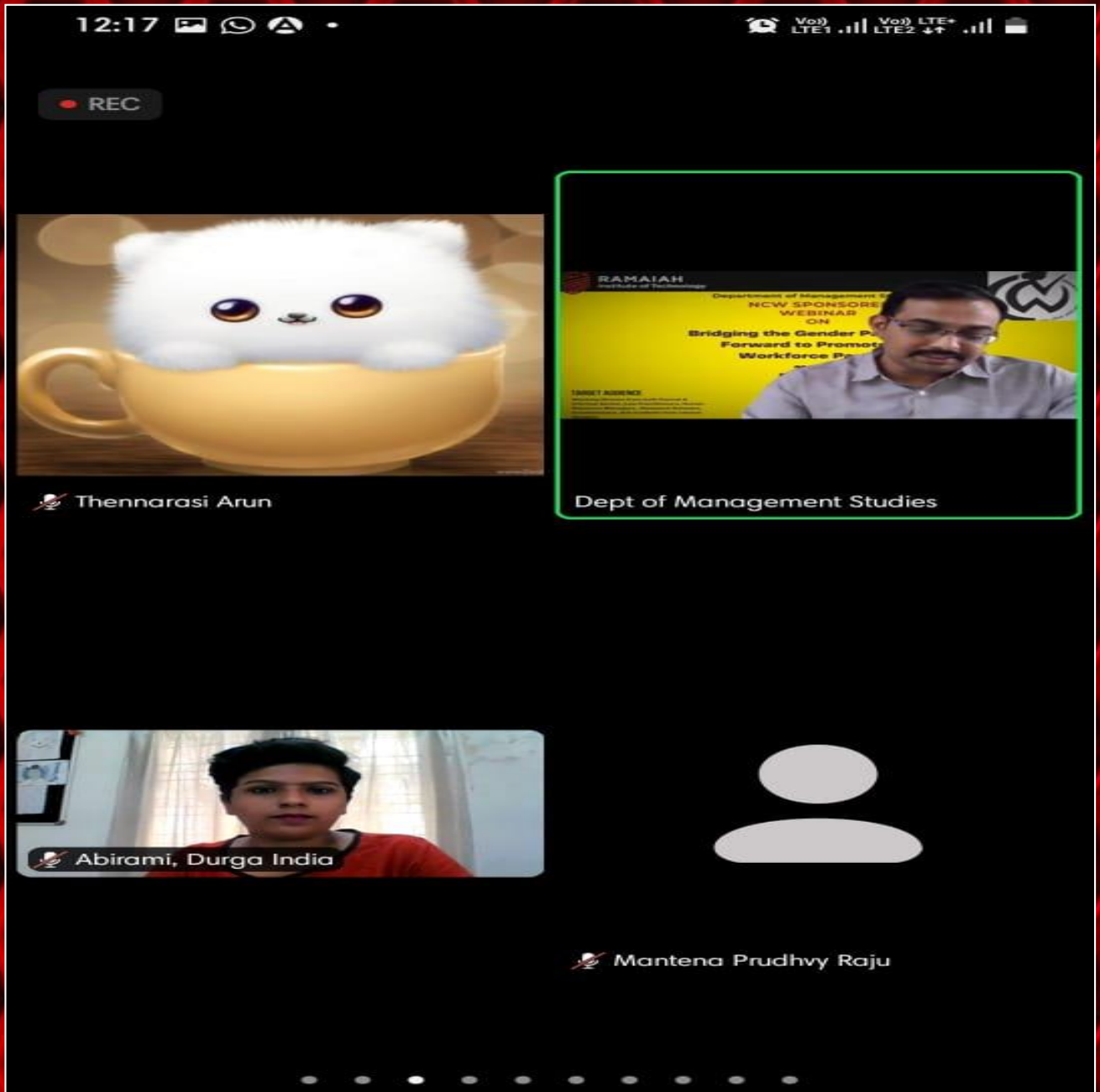

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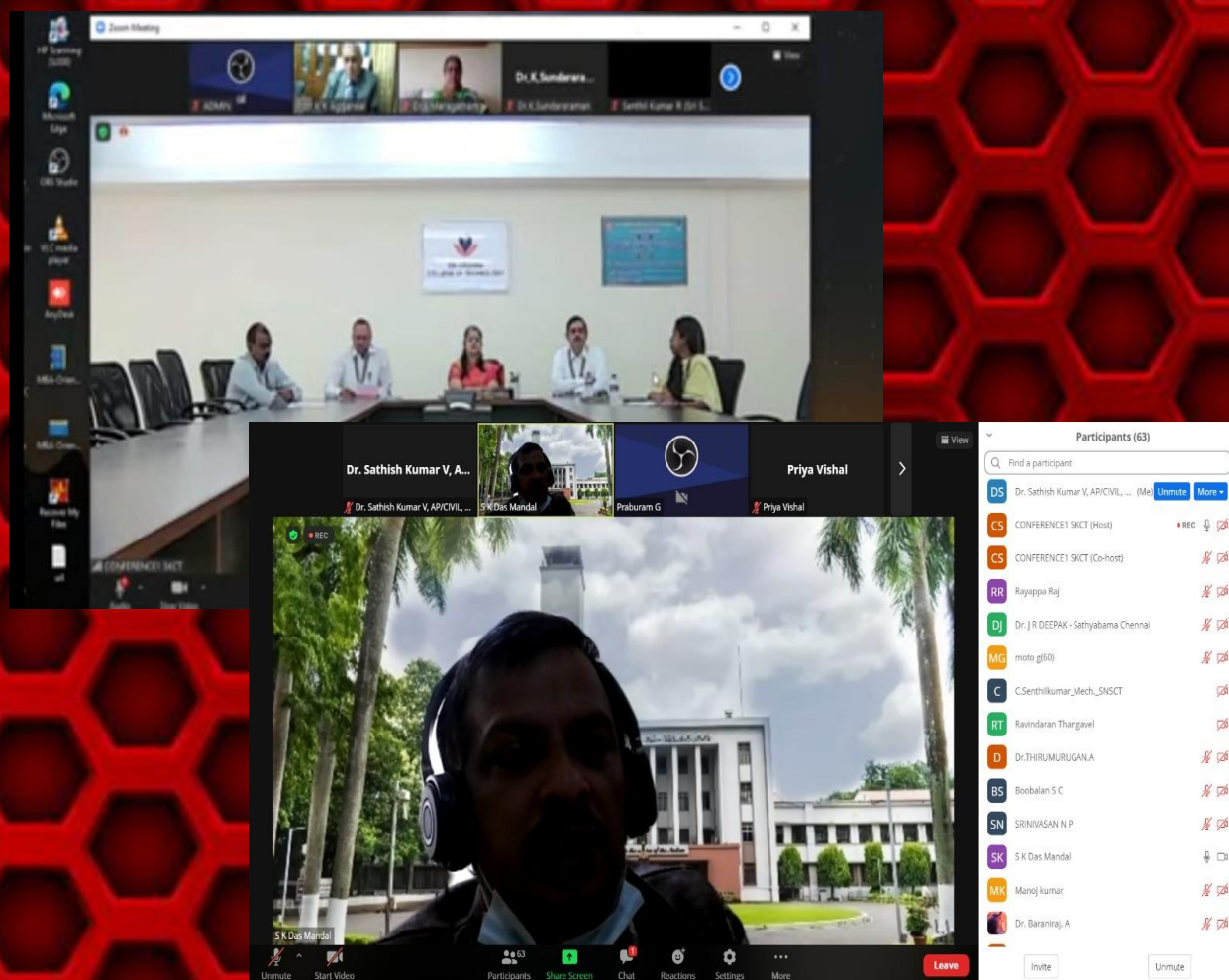

What is Assessment?

The word 'asses' comes from the Latin verb 'assidere' meaning 'to sit with'.

In assessment one is supposed to sit with the learner. This implies it is something we do 'with' and 'for' students and not 'to' students (Green, 1999).

It also standards-based as it seeks to ensure that teachers will teach to the standards and students will aim to meet or even exceed the standards.

The students' attainment of standards in terms of content and performance is, therefore, a critical evidence of learning.
