- ✓ Warli Art was first discovered in the early seventies. Warli Folk Painting depict social life and are created in a loose rhythmic pattern
- ✓ They are pretty close to pre-historic cave paintings in execution and usually depict scenes of human figures engaged in activities like hunting, dancing, sowing and harvesting
- ✓ Warli is the vivid expression of daily and social events of the Warli tribe of Maharashtra, used by them to embellish the walls of village houses

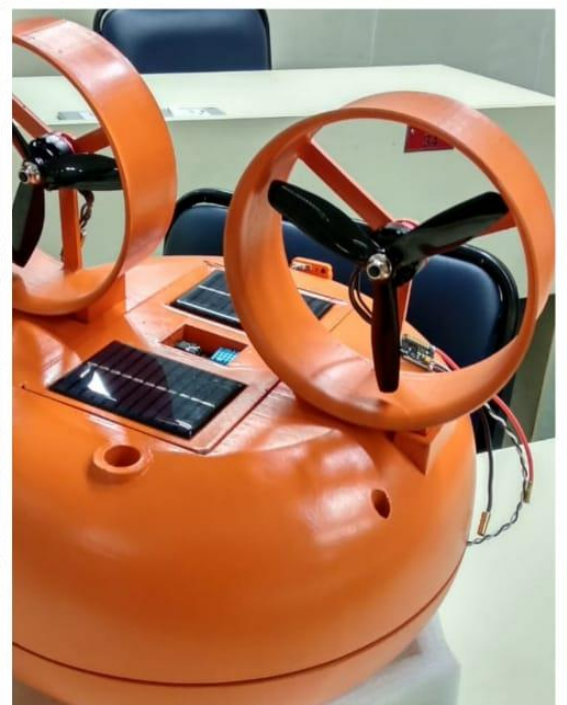

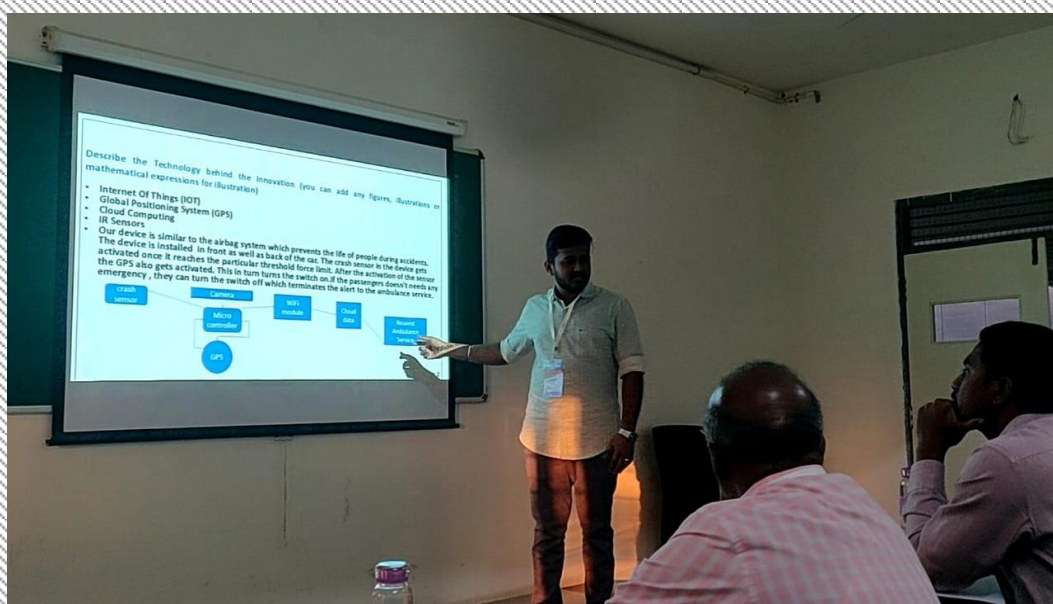

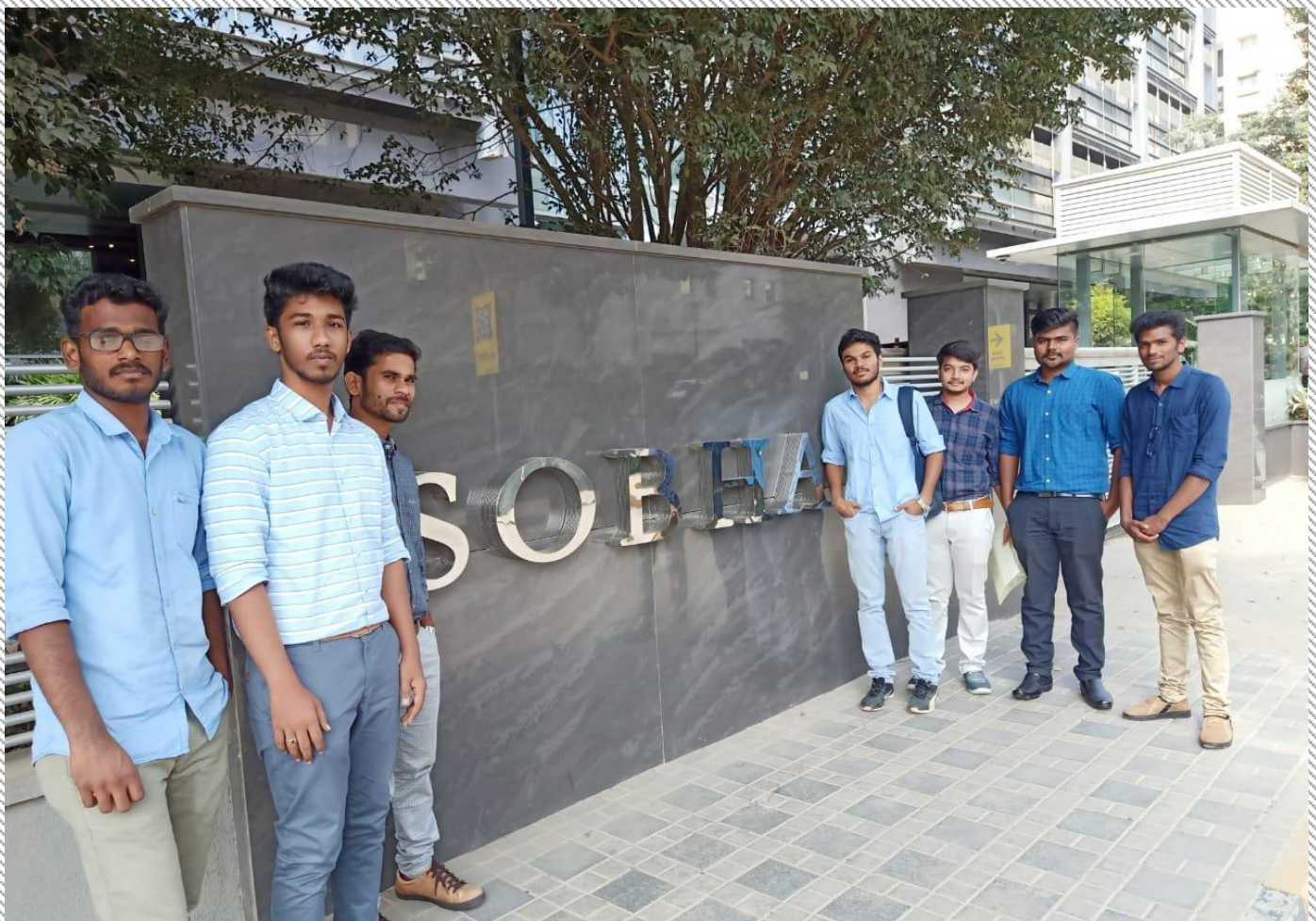
