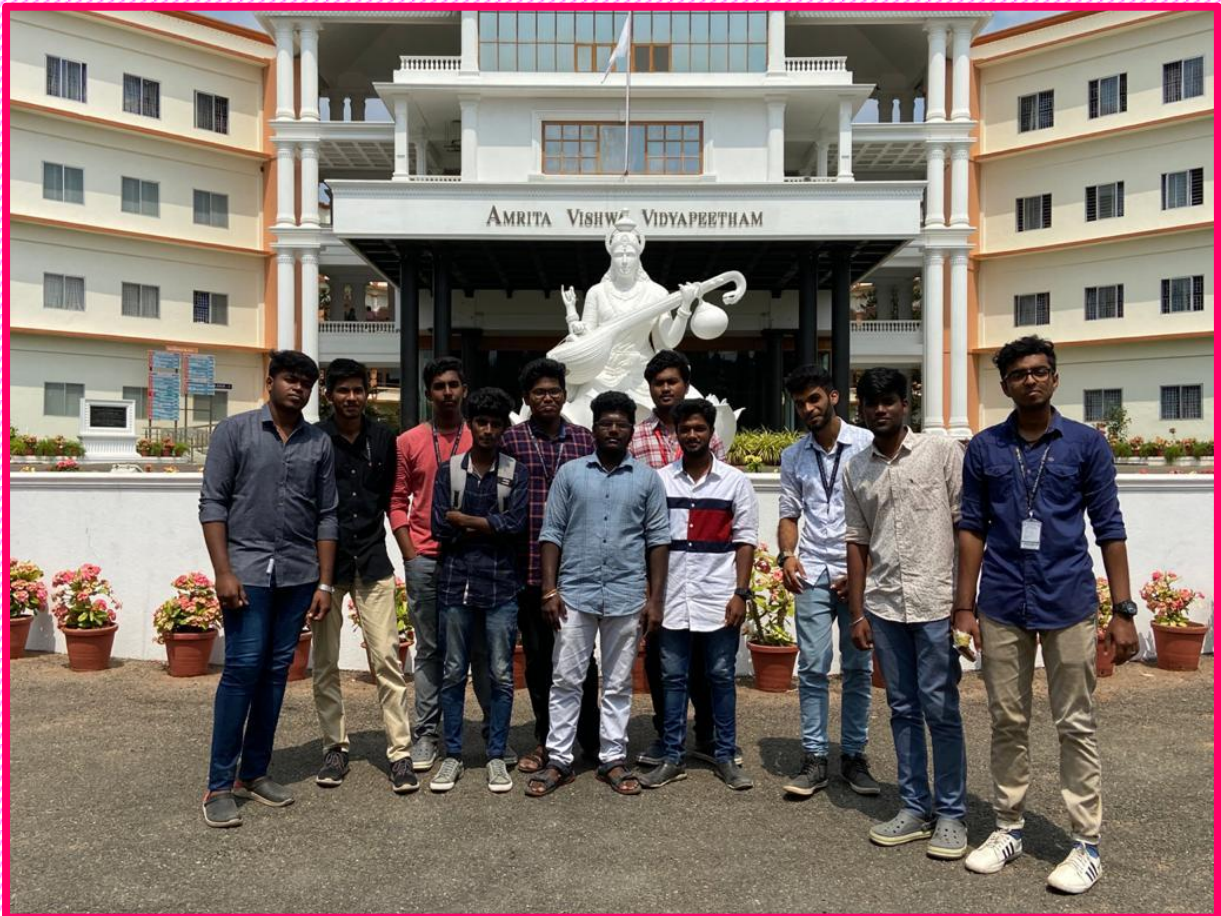

Book Chapter Published

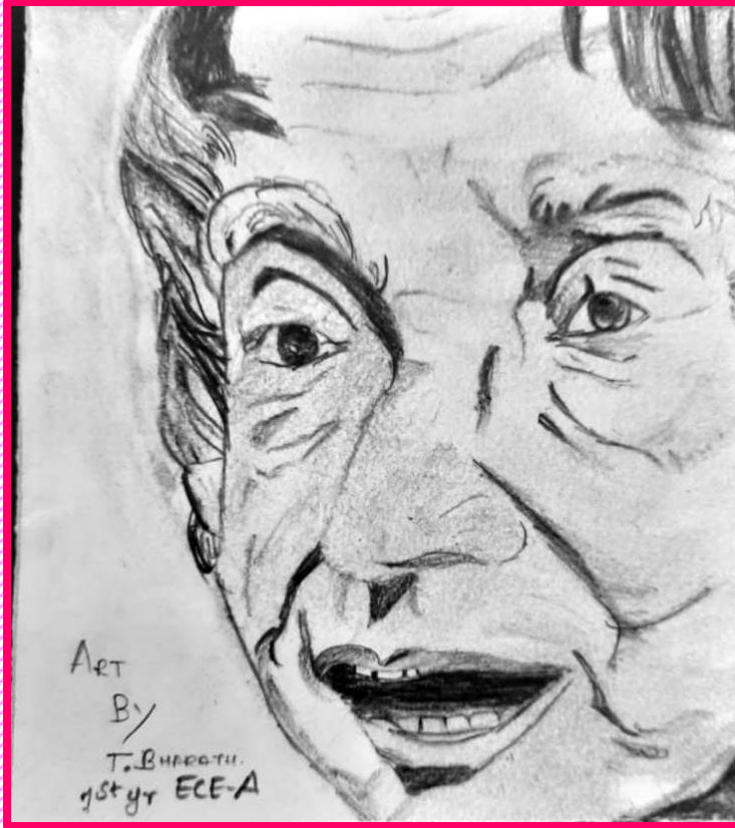

Tutelage device

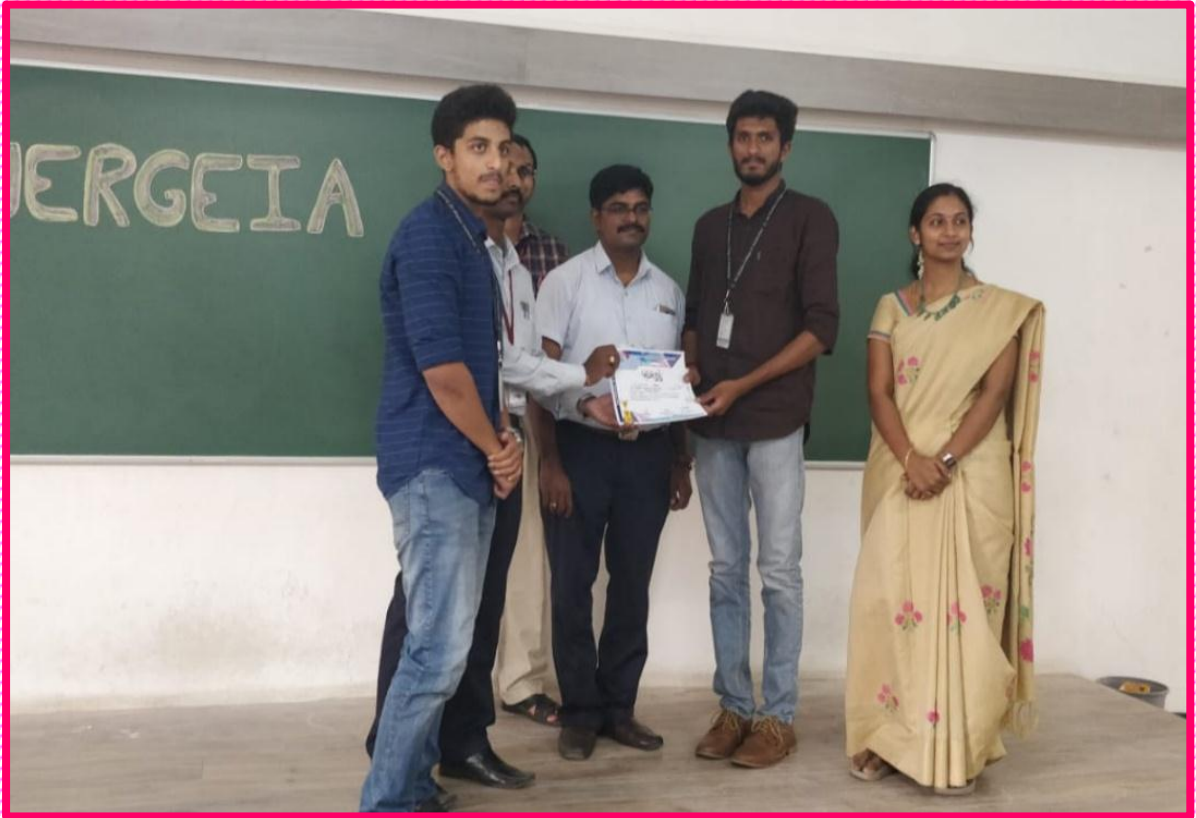
