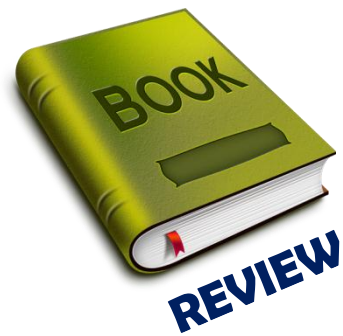
**Nybble – World's Cutest Open Source Robotic Kitten**
