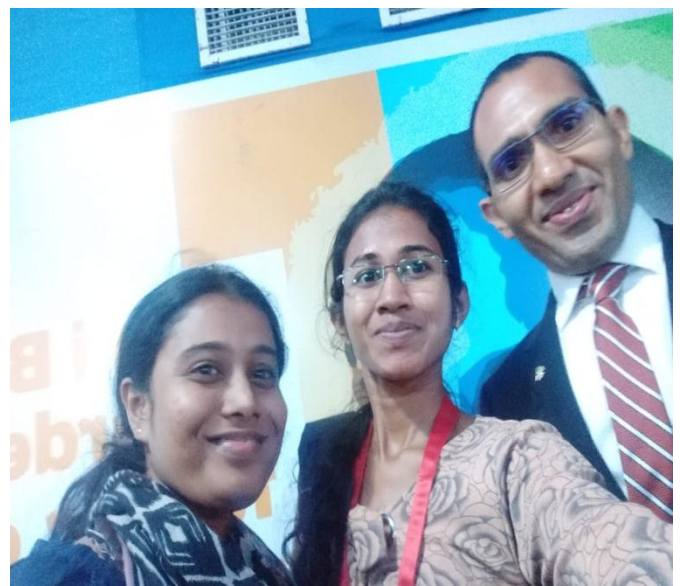

The FDP focuses towards improving the research horizons in the field of IoT.

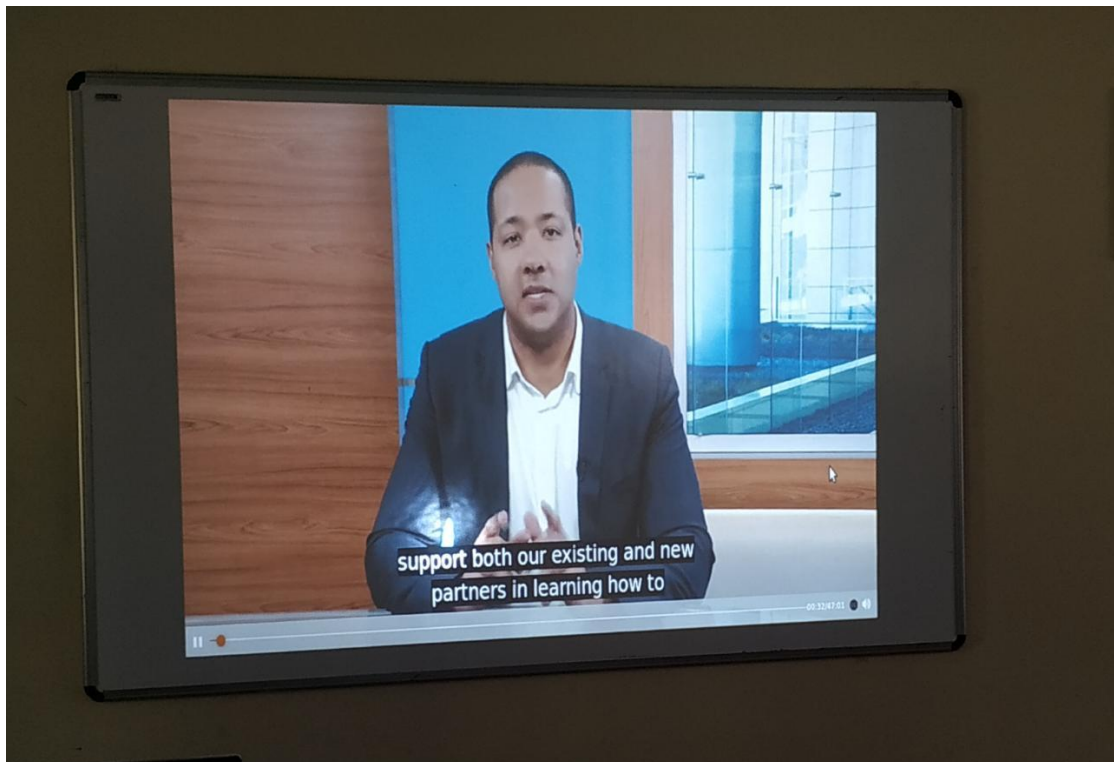
A Mathematical model for analyzing on IoT data using edge, fog and cloud computing technologies were emphasized
